Overview of the Archa Theatre's activities in 2019

2019 was the last year of the four-year grant which the City of Prague granted to the Archa Theatre for 2016 to 2019.

According to the grant agreement, in 2019 the Archa Theatre public benefit company had to stage at least 170 performances. In fact, in 2019 the theatre presented 217 performances on its own stage, which were attended by 38,948 spectators. The year 2019 was exceptional in that another 24 performances of the Archa Theatre took place on domestic and foreign tours. Performances were presented at the Avignon Festival and the Paris Autumn Festival. The tour performances were attended by a total of 8,098 spectators.

In ten cases, the Archa Theatre broadcast a performance or discussion in 2019 on the internet. These broadcasts reached 23,800 internet users, and 1,096 of them watched the broadcast.

In 2019, the Archa Theatre once again prepared an artistically demanding program for its audience within the framework of its mission, which is determined in its statutes. The theatre presented its own productions or various forms of co-production with international and local partners.

Premieres

Akce Kámen – The Czech premiere of the production by German director Florian Fischer was presented in collaboration with the Staatsschauspiel Dresden (Dresden State Theatre).

Florian Fischer sees an analogy between the way the StB created false western borders in Czechoslovakia at the turn of the 1940s and 1950s and the current phenomenon of fake news. The performance was also presented to students and leading experts on the topic took part in discussions with them. Historian Václava Jandečková provided important insight into the topic.

Magic of Decision

The Archa Theatre project commissioned by the European Parliament took place on 5 May 2019 at the House of European History in Brussels and emphasized the importance of decision-making and the weight of each individual vote in the forthcoming elections. The participatory project, prepared by FLAB members, ended with a conference of experts. Karel Janeček was invited to join the project as a partner and personally introduced the KJ21 election method.

Listen to Franz

Jan Slovák and Jan Burian Jr. focused in the premiere project on a cross-section of the work of Franz Kafka, from which Jan Slovák always selects new texts. Viewers get acquainted with diaries, letters and short stories by F. Kafka in a non-traditional stage concept with live music by Jan Burian Jr. The audience can sit or lie on comfortable pillows and loungers.

Bernard-Henri Lévy: Looking for Europe

A solo theatrical performance by the famous French "new philosopher" **Bernard-Henri Lévy**. The author and performer prepared a unique version of his project for the Archa Theatre, with which he performed in all European capitals before the European elections. A large part of the performance was devoted to Czech political history, which Bernard-Henri Lévy carefully studied for his performance at Archa. Organized in cooperation with Forum 2000

Kadinlar: Ščegetavček

In the spring, four graduates of the Archa Theatre Summer School from Slovenia, Great Britain and Turkey returned to Archa as part of their creative residency to work on their own project focused on femininity. The result of the residency was so promising that the management of the Archa Theatre invited them in the autumn to complete the project and premiere it at the Akcent Festival.

Jan Mocek: Virtual Ritual

The young theatre director Jan Mocek created a gaming performance that brings its audience into the parallel world of online video games. It is a survey of a digital society made up of millions of people who log in to the vast gaming worlds around the world every day. The game takes us to a virtual city where almost anything is possible. Urbanist Osamu Okamura, YouTuber Atlet, and photographer and gamer Adéla Vosičková accompany us through this city, which is a reflection of our reality.

The project was co-produced with the Goethe Institute and the production organization Six Houses z.s.

Vosto5: Velvet Simulation: Tribune

A spatial experiential installation with projections and sound simulating the visitors' feelings at the largest revolutionary demonstrations in November 1989 on the Letná Plain. The immersive installation was complemented by workshops and graphic workshops in the foyer of the theatre, along with other activities comparing the November ethos with that of the present day and tried to find the differences that are typical of demonstrations of the Velvet Revolution and those of today.

The project, directed by Vosto5, was dedicated to the 30th anniversary of the Velvet Revolution.

Anna Klimešová and coll.: I shall go into a hare wi sorrow and such mickle care

The original production by KALD students is named after a part of a sentence uttered by Isobel Gowdie in her confession before the Scottish Ecclesiastical Tribunal in 1662. We can call this sentence a magic formula, but does not any wish we express become such a formula? The performance sprung from the artistic residence of Anna Klimešová at Archa.lab.

Jiří Havelka, Veronika Knytlová: Studio Apartments

A dance performance based on the rituals of everyday life. Two dancers, a man and a woman, Veronika Knytlová and Martin Talaga, move quickly, economically, thoughtlessly in a small, cramped space. The couple lives together in a small space, and yet they do not meet each other.

Continuing artistic projects

Artist and performer Petr Nikl, who teamed up with technology experimenter David Vrbík and musician Jan Burian, regularly presented the production of **Yellow Darkness**. Using laser beams, they create images immersed in space-time, where birth, life and death are not causally related. Light becomes a musical instrument that draws us into unknown worlds.

The production called **Russkies?**, which was created on the basis of a dialogue between Czech and Russian artists living in Prague, asks: How do young Russians living in the Czech Republic cope with our historical complex? How do they perceive their own past? Spectators, along with the creators, embark on a journey set out by our prejudices, myths, love, hate, fear and courage. Theme: Jan Burian. Concept, commentary: Jana Svobodová. Music, sound design: Jan Burian. Scenographic concept: Jan Burian, Jaroslav Hrdlička. Video: Jaroslav Hrdlička. Choreography: Inga Zotova-Mikshina, Roman Zotov-Mikshin. Performers: Inga Zotova-Mikshina, Roman Zotov-Mikshin, Marina Sokol.

The VOSTO5 artistic group regularly presented its experimental sci-fi drama **Colonization – A New Beginning** that takes full advantage of all the technical and spatial possibilities of the Archa Theatre. Spectators find themselves on an unknown planet where they ask whether the future colonization of new planets is inevitable. Should the universe be colonized by humans? Do humans have the right to destroy the seeds of unknown life? Director Jiří Havelka uses the space of the Archa Theatre in a "site-specific" way and the initial story inspired by Czechoslovak sci-fi comics gradually culminates in an immersive theatrical experience.

The production of **Fatherland** combines elements of time-lapse live performance, documentary and video. Director Jan Mocek draws on an intimate and ambiguous situation: he meets his 34 years older father Jan Mocek on the stage. The shared name and striking physical similarity of the men is an impulse to play with an identity in which the presence of the father changes into the future of the son.

In addition to the personal, documentary level, the performance also includes a political dimension. It explores the theme of masculinity against the background of the disintegration and rediscovery of our Czech individual and collective identity.

Artists who hide their identity under the names of Thomas & Ruhller and have been moving on the border between theatre, art experiment and philosophy for decades exclusively prepared their show called **Diner** for the Archa Theatre, which they regularly perform here.

In November, Archa presented two performances of **Ordinary People**, which was created as a joint project of the Archa Theatre and the independent Chinese ensemble Living Dance Studio from Beijing. The production by director **Jana Svobodová** and choreographer **Wen Hui** confronts the authentic lives of people in the Czech Republic and China against the background of historical events. In November, it was performed at Archa after a week-long series at the Théâtre de la Ville in Paris as part of the famous Le Festival d'Automne. See below.

As part of the Archa.lab artistic residence, Spielraum Kollektiv (Mathias Straub and Linda Straub) presented **Fidlovačka or Who Are We?** The participatory performance examines Czech-German

relations, migration, new nationalism and so-called "Czech values" against the background of the story of theatre revivalist Josef Kajetán Tyl.

Four times during the year Archa presented classic puppet avant-garde performance **Piškanderdulá** by Věra Říčařová and František Vítek.

Divadlo Vizita featuring Jaroslav Dušek, Pjér la Šé´z, Zdeňek Konopásek and Viktor Zborník each month presented an improvised show.

The popular literary cabaret **EKG** by Jaroslav Rudiš and Igor Malijevský took place at Archa in a new form. It is presented in its new form twice a season (four times in total) in the large auditorium of the Archa Theatre.

Special events

Ordinary People at the Avignon Festival, Le Festival d'Automne in Paris and the NEXT Festival in Lille.

In July, the production of Ordinary People by director Jana Svobodová and Chinese choreographer Wen Hui was presented in the main program of the Avignon festival. It marked the first time a Czech theatre production had been featured in the main program after 40 long years. Ordinary People was presented in Avignon seven times.

In November, the production was staged for one week at the Theâtre da la Ville in Paris and then at the NEXT festival in Lille. A total of 18 performances took place on Ordinary People's foreign tour, which ended in Porto, Portugal.

25 Years of the Archa Theatre

On June 6, the Archa Theatre celebrated a quarter of a century of its existence with events in all its premises. Musicians and performers performed for six hours in installations prepared by Petr Nikl, Jana Svobodová, Jan Burian Jr. and Jaroslav Hrdlička. The event was attended by 1,500 fans and spectators of the theatre.

Vektroskop Festival

Part of the thematic sphere "Society 4.0", which Archa has in its dramaturgical plan, was the small Vektroskop Festival, which dealt with new technologies in the performing arts, especially the use of lasers, oscilloscopes and similar technologies. The festival took place during the Prague Quadrennial. The star of the festival was the Berlin artist Robert Henke. The festival also included a performance of Yellow Darkness.

Festival EFB

A festival commemorating the 115th anniversary of the birth of an artistic figure of European format – E. F. Burian. The festival included expert discussions, concerts by the Berg Orchestra, Jan Burian Jr., the Pavel Bořkovec Quartet, the Štěpán Uhlíř group and the theatre performance The War by director Jaroslava Šiktancová and the BodyVoiceBand art group. The dramaturg and director of the festival was the artist's granddaughter Zuzana Burianová.

La Putyka - 10 Years

Rost'a Novák, the principal of the new circus theatre ensemble La Putyka, addressed the management of the Archa Theatre with the idea that he would return to the premiere of La Putyka as part of the tenth anniversary of the founding of the ensemble. The Archa Theatre was also the site of the artistic residence that preceded the founding of the ensemble. La Putyka thus moved from its home stage of Jatka 78 to Archa for four days.

Guests from the Czech Republic

Brno's Goose on a String Theatre is a regular guest and partner of Archa also in 2019. It was also the first year of the new artistic management of this theatre. During the year, Archa invited the productions of **Amerika** (director M. Dočekal), **Vitka** (director A. Davidová), **The Gambler** (director M. Hába), **Quiet Tarzan** (director A. Davidová), **The Shithouse Rules** (director A. Davidová), **Silence on Earth** (director D. Gombár) and **Don Quixote** (director J. Mikulášek).

The Plzen ensemble Johan presented the original production **Internet of Things** by the creative tandem of Roman Černík and Jiří Honzírek, which deals with the topic of working conditions of foreign "gastarbaiters" in the countries of the former Eastern bloc. It is based on the testimony of Bulgarian and

Romanian workers obtained directly from the factories where they work. (Presented as part of the Akcent International Documentary Theatre Festival.)

International performances and collaboration

Archa.lab creative residency

During the year, Archa continuously provided residencies to selected young domestic and foreign artists. **Tears of Giant – Viah** – The first residency belonged to graduates of the Archa Summer School Huyen Vi Tranová and Rosalia Malinská, who together with Vietnamese and Czech artists formed the Lunar Collective group worked on a musically dramatic performance based on music recordings with which they won the Czeching Czech Radio Wave competition.

Anna Klimešová – I shall go into a hare wi sorrow and such mickle care. Anna Klimešová created a graduation performance with students of KALD DAMU.

Kadinlar - Ščegetavček – Four graduates of the Archa Summer School from Slovenia, Great Britain and Turkey returned with their own project focused on the topic of femininity.

Kristýna Doležalová, Lily Carmen Smith: Calm After the Storm – Students of the Theatre School in Glasgow prepared an ecological site-specific project in Přístav 18600

Tom Jaspers van Huijkelom and Lise Andrea Grimelund-Kjelsen: 1144

He is Dutch she is from Norway. They met at the Archa Theatre Summer School 2018. Their project is based on research into linguistic, cultural and economic differences on an 1,144-kilometer axis between Oslo and Amsterdam.

International theatre productions

Ishá, The Women Who...

A feminist theme of a Portuguese ensemble led by young artist Joana Brito Silva. (Presented at the Akcent International Documentary Theatre Festival.)

Tanzwerke Vaněk Preuss: Aurora's Redlines

Dance performance by the pioneer of Czech contemporary dance Karel Vaňek, who has been working in Bonn, Germany for many years. Together with Guido Preuss, he created a dance performance here, which is a reaction to the evocation of alarming news. Archa presented the Czech premiere.

Ligna: Intoxication and Anger (Rausch und Zorn)

We presented the participatory performance of the Hamburg art group Ligna in cooperation with the Bazaar festival. Based on the historical parallels of the roles of the poet d'Annunzio in Fiume (Rijeka) the performance dealt with the emotional roots of the origins of fascism. The project had a very positive response from the student audience.

Seppe Baeyens: Invited

The highly participatory performance of the Flemish dancer, who forms with the production support of the Ultima Vez ensemble, brought a diverse community of neighbours from Molenbeek, Brussels, to Archa. The performance was highly praised by the audience for its participation and was talked of as the theatre of the future.

Bernard-Henri Lévy: Looking for Europe – the above-mentioned project by the French philosopher.

Hotel Európa: Post-Colonial Loves

The Portuguese production of documentary theater works with the theme of "love", which the creators use to open a discussion on Portuguese colonialism and post-colonialism. In the artists' conception, love becomes a political act. (Presented at the Akcent International Documentary Theatre Festival.)

Sláva Daubnerová: Solo lamentoso

The production of the Slovak director and performer is inspired by a banal story on the theme of growing aversion among people. It gives the impression that extremism can be born even from banal neighbourhood conflicts. (Presented at the Akcent International Documentary Theatre Festival.)

CAMPO / Silke Huysmans and Hannes Dereere: Pleasant Island

Flemish artists base their work on specific situations, events or places. A typical feature of their work is the method of obtaining material through scientific research, interviews and field research. Their artistic research in this project focused on the inhabitants of the Pacific island of Nauru, who, together with the lucrative phosphates, also extracted all the fertile land at the same time. (Presented at the Akcent International Documentary Theatre Festival.)

Music program

A large part of the Archa music program in 2019 was based on the scenic interplay of visual arts and music. A list of all concerts can be found at www.divadloarcha.cz

In March, **Sunn O))),** the most progressive rock band according to *The Guardian*, performed at Archa. Performed by the **BERG Orchestra** conducted by Peter Vrábel, the music of **Frank Zappa** from his last album Yellow Shark and new works by composer Michal Nejtek.

Double bassist and producer **Phil France**, a member of the legendary Cinematic Orchestra, the duo **Sunda Arc**, which consists of two members of the Mammal Hands group and the founder of the Gondwana brand and the acclaimed trumpet player **Matthew Halsall**, performed at the **Spectaculare** festival at the evening of the Manchester publishing house **Gondwana Records**.

The second concert of the Spectaculare festival featured German pianist, composer and musical adventurer Volker Bertelmann aka **Hauschka**. The evening was opened by the talented Dutch composer **Pieter De Graaf**.

In March, **Please the Trees** and **Manon meurt** launched their albums at Archa. They were joined by guest **Steve Gunn**, an award-winning American troubadour.

The tenth year of the **Mladí ladí jazz** festival was opened by phenomenal London-based singer and author **Andreya Triana**.

In keeping with tradition, Jan Burian & BIZARRE BAND & DRTIVÉ JISTOTY ROCK BAND presented his new program.

In April, composer, arranger, producer, pianist, drummer and bandleader **Omar Sosa**, one of the most universal jazz artists on the contemporary scene, performed.

In July, the excellent blues singer, multi-instrumentalist and producer **Keb´ Mo** and the legend of reggae, the eight-time Grammy winner and Bob Marley's eldest son **Ziggy Marley** performed at Archa.

In September, the festival of new and Japanese music International Shakuhachi Festival Prague featured a concert by world koto virtuoso Makiko Goto, the premiere of the audio-visual project Krastí and a concert recital by legendary Japanese shakuhachi player Kuniyoshiho Sugawary.

In cooperation with the Strings of Autumn festival and Prague Music Performance, Archa presented a music program called the **Marathon of American Music**. The unique evening celebrated the dynamism, innovation and diversity of contemporary American music. Works by famous composers such as Steve Reich, Lou Harrison and Henry Cowell were performed. The compositions were interpreted by the renowned Iranian-American harpsichordist **Mahan Esfahani**, as well as the **Prague Minimal Orchestra** of Jan Rybář, violinist **Antje** Weithaas and flutist Kristýna Farag.

In November, the British trio **The Tiger Lillies** celebrated their 30th anniversary at Archa, and world-famous Irish musician **Glen Hansard** presented his new solo album **Between Two Shores**. Opening for him was Irish singer **Nina Hynes**.

Vladimír Mišík launched his new album Jednou tě potkám at Archa and Tata Bojs presented to their fans a spectacular art and music show on the occasion of the re-edition of 2LP Biorytmy.

Conferences and themed events

In addition to theatre and dance performances, the Archa Theatre organized a number of thematic events, discussion evenings and conferences about the relationship of art to current social events and issues of artistic creation. The preparation and implementation of these events, whatever their form, requires just as much hard work as the preparation of any kind of theatre performance.

Prague 1 free! – an evening on the occasion of the awarding of honorary citizenship of Prague 1. The FLAB team of the Archa Theatre created interactive installations, which resulted in a festive program, the authors of which were all the participants. During the evening, spectators could get to know Prague over time through an interactive photographic installation, share their own story in an audio workshop or try out animation, which was screened at the end of the evening.

Music publicists and critics traditionally meet at Archa each year to evaluate the domestic and world music scenes. Pavel Klusák, Aleš Stuchlý and Karel Veselý prepared a show called **Music 2018: What Happened?** They evaluated the creative summits and discoveries of the last year in independent pop and experimental music and prepared a dynamic evening full of projections, recordings, comments and inadvertent performances.

Musician, writer and artist Eva Turnová presented her show **Turnová's Grove**. The program included a reading by the author and a performance by the Eturnity group.

A trip to the creative digital world, the **Mouvo Festival** was again dedicated to the dynamic field of motion design that combines graphic design, animation, video, special effects and new technologies. The festival presented world-renowned creators and pioneers of this fast-growing creative industry to the Prague audience.

The Archa Theatre has a mission to be a meeting place for different cultures, and therefore in April 2019 it also became the venue for the culmination of the celebrations of **International Roma Day**. During the gala evening, it welcomed a number of Roma artists, music and dance ensembles to its stage.

In 2019 the Archa Theatre for the second time produced a nomination evening for the **Czech Architecture Awards** and created an artistic program for the gala evening at the Karlín Forum.

Archa also joined the **Theatre Night** in 2019 and prepared a guided tour of all areas of the theatre with a special presentation of productions.

The Archa Theatre also regularly served as the venue for the Jan Kraus Show in 2019.

Festivals

In addition to the **Akcent International Documentary Theatre Festival**, which is regularly organized by the Archa Theatre in autumn, the theatre participates in co-production at other theatre and music festivals. In 2019, these included **4+4 Days in Motion**, **Small Inventory**, **Strings of Autumn**, **Mladí ladí jazz** and **PQ+** Prague Quadrennial.

Cultural diplomacy

The Archa Theatre's long-standing work in the field of documentary and socially specific theatre was praised by the British Council for selecting it for its new project for Central European countries. The project called **People to People** is aimed at supporting civil society in areas that are most at risk of social exclusion and subsequently also through internet propaganda of so-called alternative truths.

The Archa Theatre has prepared the project Traveling Laboratory of Theatre Practice, where together with British colleagues and partner organizations in individual regions of the Czech Republic it organized workshops for local artists and active citizens who are or want to engage in participatory and community theatre. Workshops and presentations of this project took place in the Cooltour cultural centre in Ostrava and in the Hraničář centre in Ústí nad Labem.

Archa.lab

Courses and workshops for the public and professionals 2019

As part of Archa.lab, the theatre organized courses and seminars for people interested in dance and theatre from the ranks of professionals as well as courses for children and the general public.

Dancers Veronika Kacianová and Marta Trpišovská led the Dance Atelier for Children ages 4 to 6 and the Dance Atelier for Children ages 7 to 12.

Veronika Knytlová led the Physical Theatre for all Ages Atelier.

Archa.lab ateliers had 200 regular participants in total.

Dutch dancer and educator **Frank van de Ven**, in his two-day workshop, dealt with the symbiotic relationship of language and movement. Together with the workshop participants he explored how body and mind work together and how to use this knowledge for theatre and dance improvisation.

Archa for Schools

In 2019 the educational program of the Archa Theatre was in full swing. It aims to use the tools of theatre to address pupils and students of primary and secondary schools and universities. This program places artistic experience in a contact where it can create space for discussion of topics which are often taboo and hard to talk about. The Archa for Schools program consists of **morning performances** followed by discussions, **guided tours of the theatre** and **theatre workshops with specific themes**. The theatre creates accompanying teaching materials for the events in the form of methodological guides and worksheets. As part of the Archa for Schools program, **interactive workshops focused on the principles of documentary theatre** were held. The workshops presented artistic work based on joint creation. Students had the opportunity to test processes for the creation of theatre productions directly in the Archa Theatre. This year Archa for the first time organized a workshop for teachers.

Archa Theatre International Summer School

A project with global intervention took place at the turn of August and September. The Archa Theatre has organized the fourth year of the **International Summer School of Theatre in Social Context**.

From August 23 to September 6, 2019, the entire Archa Theatre was transformed into a platform for experimentation and research in the field of documentary theatre. This year, 20 participants from 16 countries passed the selection. As every year, the school was attended by students of prestigious British art schools such as Goldsmith College in London. For the second time, students from China or Iran also took part, and this year for the first time also from Africa. In the initial phase, students chose to work in one of the four main studios. Jana Svobodová's studio focused on the Viewpoints method and textual resources in the creation of socially specific theatre. Jaroslav Hrdlička's studio dealt with various ways of using video for theatre. Jan Burian Jr. encouraged students to focus on different ways of making music by taking sound as an integral part of the action. Philipp Schenker explored the relationship between objects and personal stories with students. In addition to these studios, students participated in lectures by internationally renowned experts. Ondřej Hrab focused on the historical roots of socially specific theatre and on the relationship between theatre and sociology. Dutch cultural operator Henk Keizer talked about theatre in unusual places. European cultural development expert Robert Palmer looked at visions of theatre development in the 21st century. The principles of writing dramatic text were explored by Belgian writer and playwright Pieter De Buysser. Besides these studios and lectures, the students attended a dance workshop by Zuzana Sýkorová and a light design workshop by Pavel Kotlík. In the final week of the Summer School, the participants created a small creative group in which they prepared a short performance under the guidance of the instructors.

The language of instruction was English.

The success of the summer school demonstrated the international importance of the Archa Theatre's activities and its contribution to spreading Prague's reputation around the world.

Výrok auditora

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Property depreciations

The company uses accounting depreciations, which it sets in accordance with the point of view of time, the period of applicability or in relation to performance. During depreciation the depreciation rate does not change.

Property records

Long-term intangible assets whose value is more than 10,000 CZK in individual cases and whose period of usability is longer than one year are charged to account 013 and are depreciated monthly. Small intangible assets with a value of 1,500 – 5,000 CZK with a period of usability longer than one year are accounted when put into usage and are recorded in the operational records.

X. Gifts

The company did not receive any gifts in 2019.

XI. Economic commentary

As at 31 December 2019, the company reported a pre-tax profit of 667,000 CZK, i.e. 429 000 CZK after tax.

As of this date, the company reports liquidity, i.e. the ability to meet its short-term liabilities 95%, whereas short-term liabilities exceeded current assets by 172 000 CZK.

The company's management has taken strategic and economic measures in the area of cost controlling in relation to the company's real revenues, aimed at the ongoing amortization of the resulting economic deficit. Based on detailed periodic monitoring of the centres of individual art projects, with the help of controlling, the overall budget of the company is gradually specified and immediate interventions in the art program, and thus in the planned budgets, take place. For these reasons, the company's financial condition stabilized in 2019. This trend should continue in 2020, provided there is no further crisis situation caused by the COVID-19 pandemic and provided that the grant from the City of Prague is increased by the required amount.

A. Revenues of the organization

The company's total revenues in the amount of **42 953 068 CZK** in **2019** consisted of own revenues – proceeds, revenues from external sources – grants and income from ancillary activities.

Revenue structure:

I. Own proceeds – sales from main activities – benevolent services

The Archa Theatre's own proceeds in the total amount of **17 558 000 CZK** were made up of sales of tickets to its own productions, sales from co-productions, sales from guest performances of its own projects in the Czech Republic and abroad and other proceeds.

II. Revenues from external sources

The Archa Theatre's revenues from external sources in the total amount of **23 849 000 CZK** came mainly from a grant from the City of Prague, furthermore grants – endowments from the state budget awarded by the Ministry of Culture of the Czech Republic, grants from other Czech and foreign institutions designated for individual artistic projects and proceeds from gifts. The amount of the grant from the City of Prague is based on the grant agreement on provision of a special-purpose endowment – grant to the Archa Theatre for the provision of non-profit services. The endowment was provided to the company for the period from 1.1.2020 to 31.12.2019.

III. Proceeds from additional activities

Proceeds from additional activities after tax were **1 546 000 CZK**. Profit after tax was **509 000 CZK**. Proceeds from additional activities consisted of proceeds for promotional and advertising services, from rent and lease of material assets and from rent of space and equipment.

B. Company costs

The total costs of the Archa Theatre, o. p. s. (costs for benevolent services and additional activities) for 2019 were **42 524 033 CZK**

Structure of total costs:

1. Consumption of materials and non-storable supplies:

Consumables purchases include costs for purchases of materials, power consumption and other required purchases.

2. Services

The amount of the costs for services follows from the projected method of work of our organization. In the case of the Archa Theatre, it is not possible to talk about individual performances, but rather about various artistic projects. The amount of costs reflects the artistic diversity of the projects, a high number of premieres, the major financial demands of individual projects with regard to the large percentage of international projects in the theatre's dramaturgy and the small number of permanent employees (cooperation required with a large number of high-quality external workers and companies).

a) Rent

The rent item includes costs for rent of the space used by the Archa Theatre based on the relevant agreements for rental of non-residential space, including certain services connected with rent.

b) Legal and financial services

The legal and financial fees item includes costs for attorney services, financial advice and auditor services.

c) Repairs and maintenance

This item includes the cost of maintenance, repairs and inspections of equipment and machinery and the cost of routine maintenance of the theatre space (painting, plumbing, carpentry, locksmith services, etc.).

d) Travel

Costs for services in the travel item include mainly costs for transporting people, accommodation costs and per diem costs. 90% of these costs are related to artistic projects presented by the Archa Theatre or guest performances of the theatre's own artistic projects in the Czech Republic and abroad. The remaining 10% consists of costs of travel for Archa Theatre employees only on business trips. The purpose of these trips is negotiation of dramaturgical, financial and production conditions for coproduction and guest appearances, as well as importing and exporting artistic projects, ensuring financial resources for international cooperation and ensuring high-quality purchase and service conditions when purchasing theatre technology. A large part of travel costs for employees is pre-invoiced to the partner organization which is sharing in the project (see item revenues from coproduction). The costs of travel for Archa Theatre employees are fully defrayable from the own proceeds of the company.

e) Co-production and production services

The costs of services in the co-production and production item include costs for services connected with co-production contracts for individual projects as well as production costs for services from external production companies connected with the implementation of individual artistic projects.

f) Artist fees - invoicing

The costs of fees invoiced by self-employed artists or other Czech or foreign artist organizations. The costs reflect the number of performances by guest artists and companies at the Archa Theatre.

g) Promotion

The costs for services in the promotion item consist of costs for regular monthly promotion of the Archa Theatre's program and for advertising campaigns related to individual artistic projects. These also include costs of graphic design of promotional materials and ads, printing of posters, flyers, programs and invitations, costs of media promotion (creation of radio spots, ads in the media) and costs of distribution and presentation of promotional materials, etc.

h) Costs for representation and catering

These costs mainly consist of costs for artist catering, which is mostly for foreign artists (though increasingly frequently, domestic artists also contractually request such services). This item also includes costs of refreshments during premieres of the theatre's own projects, if the theatre is unable to find a sponsor or partner for these services. The costs for representation are fully defrayable from the company's own revenues.

i) Other services

This item includes costs of services not mentioned above. 95% of these costs are part of costs of artistic projects. The remaining 5% is connected with the operation and administration of the company.

3. Personnel costs

Personnel costs include wage costs and related costs for statutory employee social security and health insurance and other personnel costs.

a) Other personnel costs

Costs for other personnel costs include artist fees for projects and external co-workers and are based on the "project" principle of work at the Archa Theatre.

Artistic other personnel costs make up about 65% of total other personnel costs. This includes fees for artists performing in Archa Theatre projects and is based on the valid artistic and licence agreements. This involves fees for actors, directors, musicians, artists, other performers and music composers, fees for set design, costume design, props and choreography, and finally a range of fees for camera operators, photographers, translators, etc.

Operational other personnel costs make up the remaining approx. 35% of total costs of other personnel costs. These include fees and payments for external operational personnel - ushers, cloakroom attendants, hall inspectors, producers of individual artistic projects, i.e. operational costs fully connected with the implementation of performances at the Archa Theatre.

b) Wage costs

The organizational schema of the theatre is set so as to meet the demanding tasks that are placed on a modern international stage working according to a project-based method. In terms of organization it is a very difficult system. Employee wages are significantly lower than the revenues of the theatre, which is one of the most important financial indicators of a "healthy" cultural organization of this type. The average wage follows from the high professional and language expertise of the permanent employees, who are mostly university and college educated (currently more than 50% of employees have a university degree). More than half of the employees make up the management of the theatre, in which most management functions are progressive, with a high degree of independent decision making and personal responsibility, and finally also extremely time demanding.

c) Statutory employee social security and health insurance

Costs for statutory social security and health insurance ensue from the above total wage costs and relevant legal regulations.

d) Other personnel costs

Other personnel costs include contributions to meal vouchers for employees. The costs of the contributions to meal vouchers are fully defrayable from the own profits of the company.

4. Income tax

Income tax from additional services – activities operated by the Archa Theatre ensuing from the relevant legal regulations. All ancillary services are operated in accordance with applicable laws.

Services operated by the Archa Theatre:

promotional and advertisement services lease and loan of movables lease of space

5. Depreciations

The amount of costs for accounting depreciations is set by ordinance 476/2003 Coll., as amended by ordinance 504/2002 Coll., which enacts certain provisions of Act No. 563/1991 Coll. on accounting as amended. This means accounting depreciations of tangible assets with a purchase value greater than CZK 3,000 and since 2010 greater than CZK 5,000. Depreciations are fully defrayable from the company's own income.

6. Other sundry costs

Other sundry costs include costs of bank and other administrative fees, or currency exchange losses, costs of insuring property and persons and other minor costs, such as fees for carnets, stamps, etc.
